What's in the bag? Featuring "The Paper Bag Princess" by Robert Munsch, discover a mystery story, fables, tangram puzzles, improvisations, and much more! Starting with Using Your Noodle, NTD improvises with simple pool noodles to show signs to learn and enjoy. Have fun with the National Theatre of the Deaf as they combine visually exciting American Sign Language with the Spoken Word to create a performance that will be seen, heard, and long-remembered.

## A Show of Hands:

Watch The National Theatre of the Deaf explore American Sign Language from behind the curtain—literally! Concealed behind a slotted curtain, actors poke their hands out in **Hand Puppets** to create scenery, tell stories, make jokes, and teach American Sign Language. Following the introduction, enjoy poems, stories, fables, and improvisation that delights all ages!
